25.2 Three Parables

Bible Passage: Luke 15

Story Point: Jesus came to save people who do not know Him..

Leaders \\ Before the kids arrive:

1. Turn on the TV in the 2 year old class.
2. Connect Keynote from the iPad to the TV via Apple TV. The iPad and technology instructions are in the drawer closest to the TV.
3. Select the appropriate lesson in Google Slides on the iPad, You will go through each slide to guide your Worship and Lesson time.

Today's Bible Story

Some people did not like that Jesus loved sinners. Jesus told a story about a man who left all of his other sheep to find the one sheep that was lost, and he celebrated. Then Jesus told about a woman who swept her whole house to look for one coin, and she celebrated when she found it. Jesus said, "All of heaven celebrates when one sinner comes to God." Then Jesus told about a man with two sons. The younger son left home and wasted his money. When

he had no more money or food, he got a job feeding pigs. He was so hungry, he wanted to eat pig food! He said, "My father's workers have plenty of food. I do not deserve to be his son, but I will ask to be his worker." When his father saw him coming, his father ran to his son, hugged him, and kissed him. His father said, "Let's celebrate! My son was lost and now is found!"

CHECK-INS AND PLAYTIME

Check-ins \

- Welcome and receive kids as they arrive.
- Introduce yourself to the child. "Hello ____, my name is Miss./Mr. ____."
- **Remind the parents that their child's safety is our highest priority. So, for the safety of their child, we must see their Security Label at pick-up. AND if their child needs them before the service, we will TEXT them.**

Playtime \ There are activity pages that go along with today's lesson available for the 2 year olds who want to color.

WORSHIP AND LESSON (2 YEAR OLD ROOM)

Toddlers join the 2 year olds. (Not all may want to join and that is okay! They are still so little and transitions can be hard)

2 Year Old Leader \

- Welcome the kids and get them excited to sing and dance for Jesus.
- Open in a 1-2 sentence prayer.
- Use Google Slides on iPad to lead the 2 worship videos.
- Play the lesson video.
- Say: **Jesus gave His life to save people from sin.**
- Optional Transition: Sing "Jesus Loves Me"
- Close in a 1-2 sentence prayer.

Assistants \

- Being in a structured classroom setting is a foreign concept to toddlers and 2 year olds. We want to meet them where they are at and point them to Jesus. To do that, help the 2 year olds and toddlers to participate by using encouraging words, facial expressions, and modeling how to engage (singing, dancing, listening, sitting down, etc.) Some kids will struggle, and that is okay!

SNACK

Toddlers \\ There are Cheerios and clean snack cups available. *Please wash, dry, and put away all of your snack cups. There is a sink in the 2 year old classroom.*

2 Year Olds \\

- Have kids sit around the tables.
- Pass out snack (Goldfish and Chex, which are gluten free) , but encourage them not to eat until after you have prayed.
- Pray thanking God for the food.
- Enjoy!

ACTIVITY \\ SHEEP CRAFT

- Sheep template (on card stock)
- Coloring supplies
- Glue sticks
- Cotton balls

Directions:

1. Allow the kid to color the sheep template.
2. Lead the kids in gluing the cotton balls to their sheep.

PICK-UP

As kids are getting picked up, ask the parents to show you their Security Label and match it to the child's name tag. Please do not send a child home with a person who doesn't have the matching Security Label.

2 Year Olds \\ Send the child home with their craft and Activity Page (even if they did not complete it). Show the parent that there are some activities they can do during the week to disciple their kids at home.
