

# **CLUB DISCOVER LESSON PLAN**

## **3 AND 4 YEAR OLDS**

### **24.4 Jesus Showed His Glory**

Bible Passage: Matthew 17; Mark 9; Luke 9

Story Point: Jesus showed His glory to Peter, James, and John.

<b>SCHEDULE</b>	
8:15 - 9:00	Check-ins and Playtime
9:00 - 9:10	Snack
9:10 - 9:30	Circle Time: Worship and Lesson (Classroom)
9:30 - 9:45	Craft/Activity
9:45 - end	Free Play

Leaders \\ Before the kids arrive:

1. Turn on the TV in the 3/4 Year Old classroom.
2. Connect Google Slides from the iPad to the TV via Apple TV. The iPad, remotes, and technology instructions are in your clipboard.
3. Select the appropriate lesson in Google Slides on the iPad, You will go through each slide to guide your Worship and Lesson time.

## **CHECK-INS AND PLAYTIME**

Check-ins \\

- Welcome and receive kids as they arrive.
- Introduce yourself to the child. "Hello \_\_\_\_, my name is Miss./Mr. \_\_\_\_."

- **Remind the parents that their child's safety is our highest priority. So, for the safety of their child, we *must* see *their Security Label at pick-up*. AND if their child needs them, we will TEXT them.**

Playtime \\ There are activity pages available for those who would like to color.

## **SNACK**

- Have the kids leave their toys behind in the playroom for "nap time."
- Have kids sit around the tables.
- Pass out snack (Goldfish and Chex, which are gluten free) , but encourage them not to eat until after you have all prayed together.
- Invite a child to pray, thanking God for the food.
- Enjoy!

## **CIRCLE TIME \\ WORSHIP AND LESSON (CLASSROOM)**

Leader \\

- Lead 3 and 4 year olds to the carpet for "circle time."
- Get to know each other by singing "Who came to church today" to the tune of "Pop Goes the Weasel"

Who came to church today, church today, church today?

Who came to church today?

What's your name?

- Open in a 1-2 sentence prayer.
- Sing 2 worship songs
- Play the lesson video and help the kids retell the story.
- 4 Questions
  - What did you like about this story?
  - What did you not like about this story?
  - What did we learn about people?

- What did we learn about Jesus?

- **Say Christ connection: Jesus showed His glory to Peter, James, and John. Jesus said He would die, rise from the dead, and go back to heaven. One day, Jesus will come again in His glory to make everything new.**
- Assistants \\\
- Being in a structured classroom setting is still a skill that 3 and 4 year olds are learning. We want to meet them where they are at and point them to Jesus. To do that, help the kiddos to participate by using encouraging words, facial expressions, and modeling how to engage (singing, dancing, listening, sitting down, etc.) Some kids will struggle, and that is okay! We are all learning together :D

## ACTIVITY \ \ SUNCATCHER

- 2 sheets of clear contact paper per kid
- Tissue paper squares
- 2 Craft stick frames per kid
- White glue
- Coloring supplies
- 10" of yarn
- Tape

Directions:

1. Provide each kid with two sheets of clear contact plastic. Help the kids remove the backing from one.
2. Show them how to tear bits of tissue paper and stick them to the contact plastic. Instruct the kids to leave about a half-inch border around the edge.
3. When kids finish sticking bits of colored tissue paper to their first sheet, help them remove the back from the second sheet and place it over the first sheet so that the two sticky sides are facing inwards, sealing the tissue paper inside.
4. Color the frames with fun designs
5. Help them glue the picture craft stick frames to their colorful contact paper creations, one on each side to build a study frame.
6. Tape the yarn to the frames to form a hook.

Say • These sun catchers will look beautiful when sunlight shines through them. Today we learned about a time Jesus shone brightly with glory. What do you think that would have been like to see?

## PICK-UP

As kids are getting picked up, ask the parents to show you their Security Label and match it to the child's name tag. Please do not send a child home with a person who doesn't have the matching Security Label.

Send the child home with their craft and Activity Page (even if they did not complete it). Show the parent that there are some activities they can do during the week to disciple their kids at home.
