



## Game: Musical Chairs (4 Year Olds - Kindergartners)

### Supplies:

- Speaker hooked up to a phone that has the Kids Min Spotify Playlist
- Chairs (1 less than the number of kids playing)

### Instructions:

1. Put the chairs in a circle facing out OR back to back in two lines.
2. Play the music. As the music plays the kids must walk around the chairs.
3. Spontaneously stop the music. When the music stops, the kids must race to sit in a chair.
4. Whoever is remaining is out.
5. Remove one chair and keep playing until just one child remains!
6. Repeat the game until the rotation is over.

## Game: Shufflebuns (1st - 5th Graders)

### Supplies:

- Chairs (1 less than the number of kids playing)

### Instructions:

1. Put the chairs in a circle facing inward. Select one kid to be "it" and stand in the middle. All the other kids must sit in a chair.
2. As the leader, call out "Go to the right" or "Go to the left" (You might need to remind them which direction is left and right before starting). When you call it out, the kids must move to the chair in the direction you called out, and continue moving until you call out a new direction. Literally, their "buns" are shuffling from chair to chair.
3. If you yell out "switch", they must switch the direction they are going.
4. Meanwhile, the person who is "it" must try to swoop in and try to steal a persons seat as they are in transition. If they are successful, the person who was "it" now gets to shuffle with the group, and the person who lost their spot is now "it".
5. Repeat until the rotation is over.
